Granville Island has a great many things to do, art galleries and artisans studios, a huge public market selling a huge variety of food and drink items, many smaller buildings incorporating many different vendors. On the weekends, there are often performers outside, however if you prefer there are also indoor theatres. There are a several stand alone fine dining restaurants as well as a kids only market, sailing schools and many other things to see and do. It is a lovely place to wander around and there is a small ferry boat that travels across False Creek to Yaletown (another fun place to browse) as well as Science World <http://www.scienceworld.ca/> which houses the Omnimax theatre.
