

Report to Provincial Steering Committee  
December 4, 2008 meeting

Whole Region

- **Janette Bagabuyo**, has completed the work on a *Program Logic Model* [PLM] and *standard contract* for all IDP within the Interior. These were circulated and reviewed during a Regional conference call November 24<sup>th</sup>. The new contract will be reviewed & used with each agency as the contracts come up for renewal.
- *Conference Calls* – continue to be a valuable way to keep connected. Upcoming calls are January 19 and March 30.
- *Mitchell Scale* – Many communities are looking forward to beginning the Mitchell process using the updated version that is slated to be complete [reference updates only left to do] by end of February 2009. **Marcia Julian** has indicated that there may be funds to help with the cost of having a Mitchell evaluation performed.
- *MCFD ECD/CYSN planning meeting* – The latest conference call takes place December 3<sup>rd</sup> - after the writing of this report so I will report on it verbally.
- *BCEHP – Interior conf call* - The latest conference call for this group also takes place December 3<sup>rd</sup> - after the writing of this report so I will report on it verbally.

My work within the Region

- I trained new staff of the *Lilloett IDP program* on the ASQ and ASQ-SE screening tools; we also touched on AEPS [Assessment, Evaluation & Planning System curriculum] and Responsive Teaching. We plan to meet in January together with new staff from *Kamloops IDP* to cover the latter two topics.
- I continue to provide much of my support to programs through *emails and phone conversations*. . . both spontaneous and regularly scheduled. During the past two months I was in touch with *Salmon Arm, South Okanagan, Lilloett, Williams Lake, East Kootenay, Boundary, Kamloops, West Kootenay, Creston and 100 Mile House* staff.
- I attended on behalf of the Region a retirement celebration for **Diana Erickson** in Salmon Arm. Diana worked for many years in Prince George, was Regional Advisor to the North for a number of years [participating in *Mitchell scale* work] and then served families in the Salmon Arm area. IDP staff from Vernon, public health nurses, a speech pathologist and a co-worker from the agency attended the coffee hour and/or luncheon. Photos should be on the website soon.
